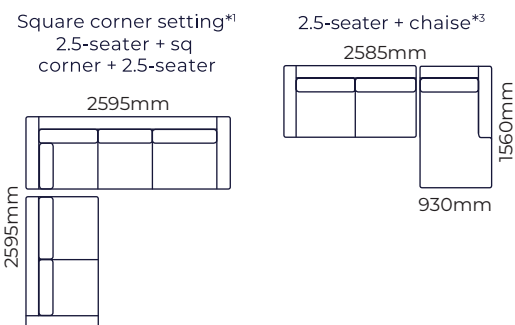

Due to the nature of foam and fabric all furniture dimensions could be +/- 20mm.

*1. In a square corner setting the corner piece is always 'built on' to the smaller of the two sofas specified as standard, but can be purchased separate if preferred.

*2. Legs are Wenge as standard.

*3. Chaise cushion width is always made to match adjoining piece. Chaise can come with one or two arms to make a stand alone Chaise-chair piece.

*4. Sofa beds have 270mm deep front borders. We use T47 or T27 legs (70mm).
